We have listed each team and what they are scheduled to bring along with a rough estimate on what to expect.

Team Responsibilities

- **Arlington Assembly** - 160 cans of pop and sound system
- **Arlington Free Methodist** – 300 slices of cheese
- **Arlington Gospel Hall** - BBQ's and chefs, Tables and 400 water
- **Bethany Assembly** – Salads(green and dressing, macaroni, potato)
- **Calvary chapel Everett** - BBQ's and chefs and 12 large bags of chips
- **Calvary Chapel Marysville** - 12 large bags of chips
- **Granite Falls Community Church** - Condiments (Ketchup, Mustard, Mayo and Relish)-enough for 300 burgers and 240 hotdogs
- **Lake County Baptist** – Buns (150 hamburger and 120 hot dog)
- **Marysville First Baptist** – 12 dozen cookies
- **Mosaic** – Salads (green and dressing, macaroni, potato)
